



OUR TERMS AND CONDITIONS ARE DESIGNED TO SAFEGUARD THE HEALTH AND WELL- BEING OF YOUR CAT

Please bring your cat in a safe cat carrier; this can be left with them at the cattery.

We request that cat collars are removed, prior to your cat arriving for its stay.

Unless explicitly requested otherwise, we may photograph and video your cats (s) for use on our Facebook page, or use them in our marketing material. All such materials will be the property of Celtic Cattery.

A non-refundable deposit of £20 per cat will secure your booking. This is payable by cash, cheque or card. Cancellation of/and amendments to the full boarding period within 14 working days of its commencement will require payment of the full boarding fees. In the event of the owner returning before the end of the booked period, the full period will still be charged. We are happy to accept payment in the form of direct transfer, cash, cheque or card, on day of arrival, or day of departure and all days booked are charged for.

Any cats suffering or believed to be suffering from any infectious disease cannot be accepted. All cats are examined on arrival and the proprietor reserves the right to refuse admission of any cat. Whilst we ensure care and attention is given to your cat(s) in our care, all cats are left at their owners risk the proprietor cannot be held responsible for any illness, disease or death that may occur during boarding.

We require all cats to be fully inoculated against Feline Infectious Enteritis, and Cat Flu. You may wish to have your cats vaccinated against Feline Leukaemia and Chlamydia, these are optional. Vaccination cover must be current with boosters up-to-date and certificates will be required. Vaccination certificates will be inspected at every visit and held for the duration of the stay. Owners must ensure that the vaccinations have had sufficient time to provide immunity (minimum 7 days after primary vaccination course, and 2 days after boosters) before start of boarding.

A 100% cancellation fee will be charged to any customer who arrives at the cattery on their arrival day without their cats being fully vaccinated.

All cats should have been recently wormed and up to date with flea treatment; preferably treated more than 5 days before admission. Please refer to our Flea policy

We will happily administer medicines and flea products provided by the owner. These must be in clearly labelled containers stating the cat's name, the frequency and dosage requirements. Whilst we are prepared to administer any necessary medication as prescribed by a Vet and will do so with the greatest of care, we will not accept any liability for problems arising as a result of the medication given. Veterinary attendance will be sought if deemed necessary and any treatment will be carried out if advised.

To enable Celtic Cattery to perform its obligations, for health and well being of all cats in our care the customer agrees:

- i) To provide us with any information reasonably requested regarding the health and behaviour of their cat(s).
- ii) To give permission to contact their Vet for advice if their cat shows any sign of illness and for treatment to be carried out by Celtic Cattery's Vet at the owner's expense.
- iii) To comply with all other requirements as set out in the Terms and Conditions
